Eligibility: This program is being delivered in partnership with Intact Public Entities (IPE) at a heavily subsidized rate for Canadian local governments. Local governments insured by IPE are able to participate at no cost. All other Canadian municipalities may participate at the subsidized rate of \$850. Minimum three staff per participating local government. Local elected officials are welcome to participate. Very small local governments can include two staff and one local elected official. Participating staff should be cross-functional, ideally including a finance official or senior administrator, public works or engineering staff, environmental sustainability or planning staff.

Note: small local governments with populations under 1,000 that collaborate on asset management with neighbouring local governments may apply together to develop a single roadmap.

The expression of interest is non-binding on all parties. Space is limited for this program and preference will be given to those insured by IPE. NAI will contact local governments to confirm participation.
